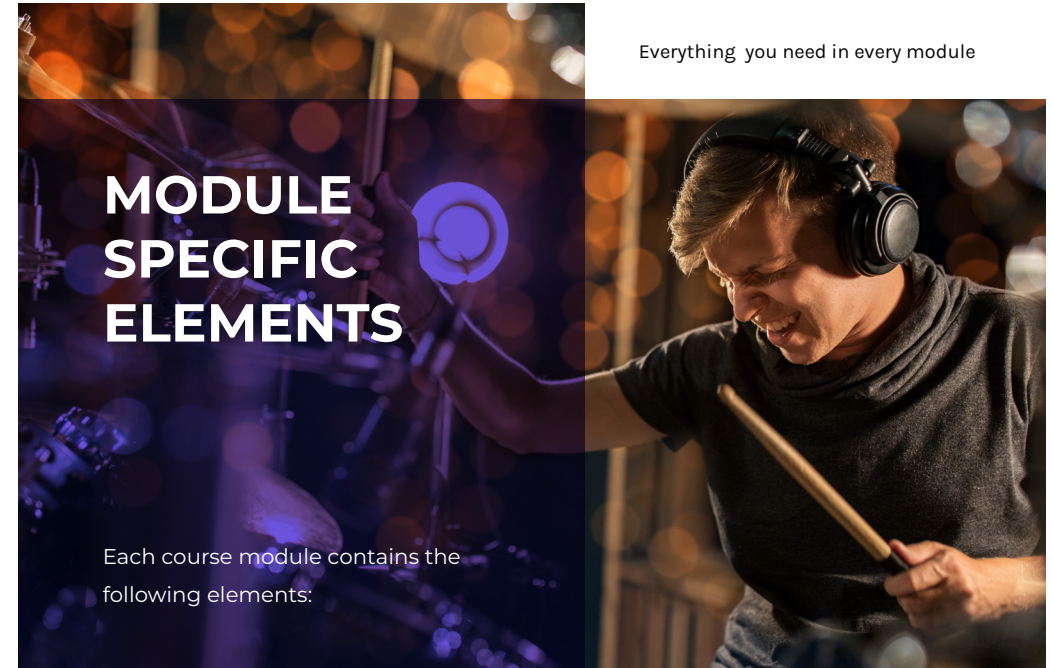
# COURSE DESCRIPTION

## MODULE SPECIFIC ELEMENTS

Each course module contains the following elements:

- 1 An introductory opportunity for reflection and motivation that includes tips on designing practice routines, developing practice habits, organizing time, finding resources, and following a path of personal growth.
- 2 Weekly sequential music theory and musicianship exercises that focus on developing skills in a wide variety of topics including pitch and rhythm notation, expressive marks, meter, and ear training.
- 3 The profiles of a significant piece of music, composer, or performer that serve as the basis for discussion and/or written assignments.
- 4 Reminders of course requirements including tracking practice hours, setting-up mentor meetings, posting of peer reviews, preparation of recitals and juries.
- 5 Information on how to level-up and apply for ABRSM certification (if desired).
