

WHAT DOES A C4ESTUDIO MENTOR DO?


A mentor is an online coach that helps the student improve their performance skills and reach their individual goals.




MENTORS DON'T...

- select students students select a mentor. •
- give any student grades (the institution will do this). •
- participate in class management (the institution instructor at the student's home campus will do this).

MENTORS MAY...

- provide students initial level placement.
- assist with the student's initial level placement.
- offer chamber music, choir, or ensemble opportunities through lowlatency streaming technology.
- help students with level advancement if required.
- participate in jury evaluations if invited by the student's school.

COURSES

C4E**Studio** courses are built for sequential study using ABRSM curriculum materials.

This leveled approach helps students set goals and evaluate progress as they work asynchronously with the support of a mentor. Following the ABRSM graded levels is not required but is strongly recommended because of its many benefits.



REPERTOIRE

Mentors should be familiar with ABRSM level repertoires



SOLOS

With mentor support, students choose their 3 solos from the ABRSM list.

Mentors should be ready to suggest repertoire in their initial meeting with a student along with appropriate exercises, scales, supplementary methods, etc.

One solo of their choice toward performance certification and leveling-up. Repertoire can be selected either from the ABRSM lists, another work suggested by the mentor, or a piece the student wishes to study.

TYPES OF MENTORS

Mentors can be a professional teacher or community coach.

Professional teacher:

Must have a minimum of a master's degree in music or equivalent experience and an association with an institution of higher learning.

Community coach:

Must have a bachelor's degree in music or equivalent experience. Equivalency is individually evaluated by the C4E team through evidence of significant teaching and/or performance experience.




The application includes all instructions including uploading...
